On the occasion of the Bauxite & Alumina Conference, Société Minière de Boké (SMB) reaffirms its position as a global leader in bauxite and its commitment to the development of Guinea

Conakry, April 2024 — Société Minière de Boké (SMB), the world's leading bauxite producer, confirms its industrial leadership and pivotal role in the economic development of Guinea by announcing its participation in the 28th edition of the Fastmarkets Bauxite & Alumina Conference, scheduled for April 22-23, 2024, in Miami, Florida.

In 2023, Guinea became the world's leading bauxite producer, with a record production of nearly 126 million tonnes, bolstering its influence in the mining sector. SMB has made significant contributions to this success by establishing itself as Guinea's leading producer and exporter of bauxite.

Moreover, SMB stands out for its deep commitment to the economic and social development of Guinea, including initiatives such as the construction of key infrastructure like the Port of Boké, Guinea's largest multipurpose port linking Guinea to Singapore and China, and the railway line between Dapilon and Santou, which increases production while enhancing the safety of mining logistics. Additionally, by facilitating mining operations in the Boké region and supporting agricultural and agro-industrial activities along the corridor, SMB contributes to long-term economic diversification.

SMB recognizes the importance of promoting inclusive development by considering the interests of local communities. Its actions in terms of employment, infrastructure modernization, and economic growth stimulation across Guinea.

"We are positioning Guinean bauxite as a competitive ore, thereby ensuring SMB's position as a leader in the global market. As the leading bauxite producer on the African continent, SMB has played a decisive

role in bringing Guinea back among the top three global bauxite producing countries. This significant advancement has shaped Guinea as a model of excellence in bauxite exploitation and exportation, ensuring that the benefits of this resource fully benefit the Guineans," stated Ismael Diakité, Chief Representative of the SMB-Winning Consortium and President of the Chamber of Mines of Guinea.
